

Neosho County 4-H Development Fund Scholarship Application

The Neosho County 4-H Foundation has funds available for a scholarship for Neosho County 4-H members interested in furthering their education. These funds may be used for vo-tech, Community College or a four-year accredited university program. The scholarship will be awarded to a full-time college student (enrolled in 12+ hours/semester).

This scholarship is worth \$500 and is payable to the recipient one-half the amount upon enrollment and the remainder upon re-enrollment the second semester. The scholarship awardees must maintain a “C” grade point average in order to collect the balance of the scholarship for the second semester. No winner may receive the scholarship more than once and it is not renewable.

Those eligible to apply for this scholarship must have been a member of the Neosho County 4-H program for at least three years. Former Neosho County 4-H members are eligible to apply for this scholarship up to five years after graduating from High School or receiving their GED. 4-H club records, leadership, financial need, and scholarship shall be considered in the selection.

The application must include the following:

The written application

4-H record book

An original High School transcript

One letter of recommendation from school personnel

One letter of recommendation from a 4-H leader or agent

All documentation is to be forwarded to the Southwind Extension District – Erie Office, 111 South Butler, Erie, KS 66733 July 1st of the year to be awarded.

The Scholarship review committee will be appointed by the Neosho County 4-H Foundation.
